

Dunboyne M3 Commuter Rail

Travelling by Train

Some tips to make your journey more straightforward:

- Buy a smartcard or season ticket to save time and money - you can top up your smartcard online!
- Ask your employer about Tax saver to get up to 51% off the cost of your monthly or annual tickets - for more information, check www.irishrail.ie
- If you're using the ticket office, always allow time at the station before departure to purchase your ticket. You must have a valid ticket prior to boarding.
- Pay parking applies at Dunboyne Station 24/7.
- Check www.irishrail.ie or follow twitter.com/irishrail for up to date service information.
- Fold-up bicycles can be carried on commuter trains, in their covers. Other bicycles should be parked at the station.

City Centre

Dunboyne (M3) Commuter rail services will operate to and from Docklands Station (Monday to Friday) and Connolly Station (Saturday & Sunday).

Intermediate stations served will be (Monday to Friday) Clonsilla, Coolmine, Castleknock, Phoenix Park and Ashtown, terminating at Docklands. At weekends, services will operate non-stop from Clonsilla to Connolly. You can also travel to Leixlip and Maynooth by changing trains at Clonsilla.

Docklands

Docklands Station, adjacent to the IFSC, offers easy access to the city centre, and excellent onward connections.

Walking

The IFSC is on your doorstep at Docklands Station, and there is a direct pedestrian access to Spencer Dock. A wide area is within 15 minutes walk of Docklands Station, as far as O'Connell Street and Trinity College. The South Quays and Grand Canal Dock area are also easily accessed via the new Samuel Beckett Bridge.

Bus

The 151 service calls at Docklands Station, connecting you to the city centre (Custom House Quay, Eden Quay etc.) and onwards to Adamstown. Full route details are available at: www.dublinbus.ie

Luas

The Red Line Luas stop at Spencer Dock is just a short 5 minute walk from Docklands Station, connecting you to the Point, the City Centre, and onwards along the Red Line to Tallaght.

Connolly

Connolly Station connects to the DART and Commuter network, Belfast, Sligo and Rosslare Intercity services. It is also adjacent to Busaras for the national bus network, and connects with the Red Line Luas and a range of Dublin Bus services.

Dunboyne M3 Commuter Rail

M3 Parkway

M3 Parkway Station is the largest public transport park and ride facility in the country. With 1,200 spaces, commuters from across Co Meath and beyond can travel to M3 Parkway and connect from the M3 to the new station, avoiding the road congestion ahead.

Journey time from M3 Parkway to Dublin City Centre will be as little as 31 minutes at peak times, and trains will operate approximately every 30 minutes at peak and off-peak. Check timetables at www.irishrail.ie or pick up a route flyer from the station.

Parking at M3 Parkway will be free initially.

This guide will help make your journeys and onward connections as simple as possible.

Dunboyne

Dunboyne Station, on Station Road in Dunboyne (R156) is just beyond the Millfarm Estate as you go towards Clonee, and within walking distance for most commuters living in Dunboyne.

Cyclists are catered for also with extensive bicycle parking, and park and ride is also available with a 300 space car park. Car park charges are €2 per day, €8 per week, or €30 per four weeks.

Journey time from Dunboyne to Dublin City Centre will be as little as 27 minutes at peak times, and trains will operate approximately every 30 minutes at peak and off-peak. Check timetables at www.irishrail.ie or pick up a route flyer from the station.
